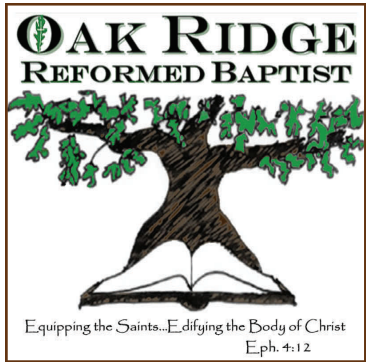

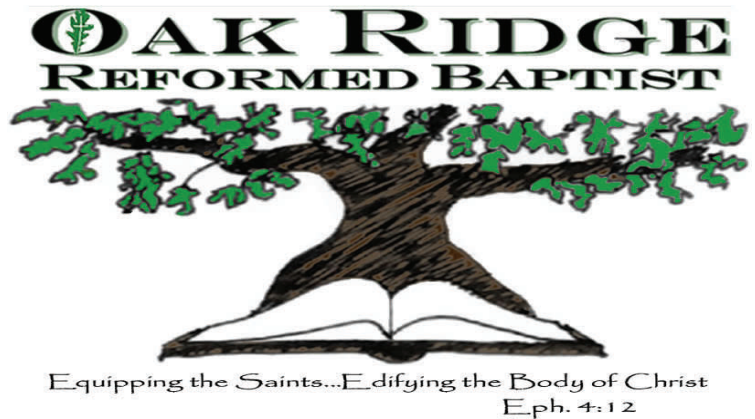

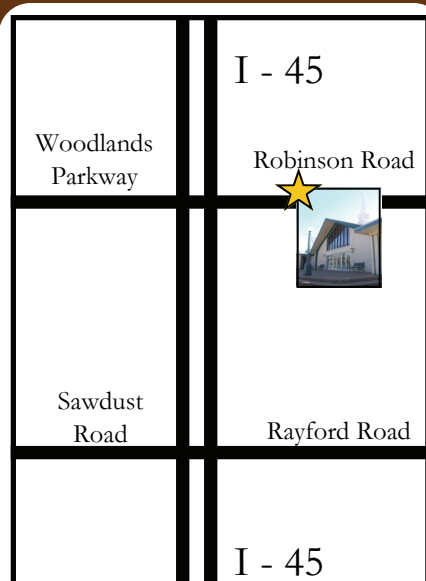


Oak Ridge Reformed Baptist Values
