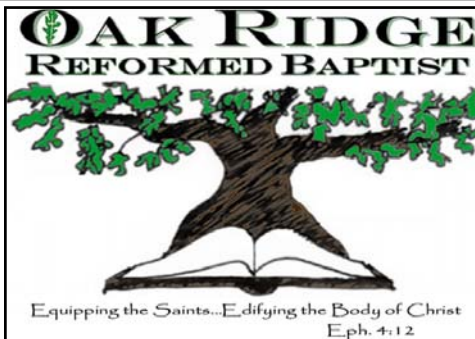

Greetings from our Pastor-Teacher, Jess Larson...

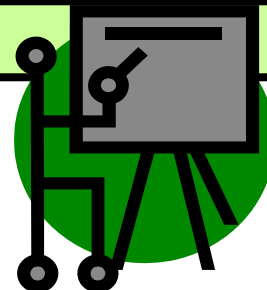

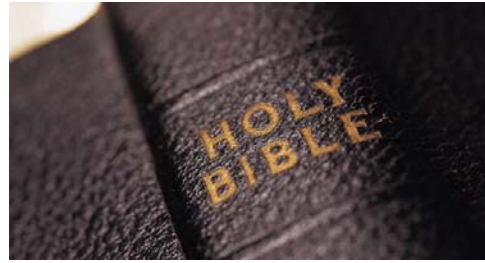

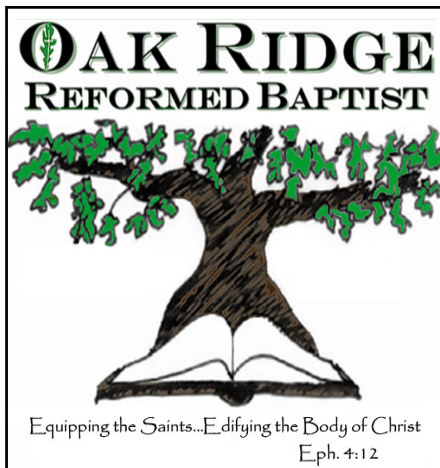
