

Sunday Night Equipping – God's Will (part 1)

4 General Questions:

1. Define "God's Will."
2. Can God's Will be known? If so, how do you discover/know it? How does God reveal it?
3. How would you describe the way that the Holy Spirit "leads/guides" you? In other words, how do you know what to do in a particular situation? How confident (give a percentage) are you that you are doing God's Will?
4. What is the general way that you go about making a decision (list steps & indicate how much influence you give to each source of guidance)?

7. You have certain convictions about what God's Will is. You look around and see other brothers and sisters in Christ living quite differently. What should your response be? Take entertainment for example: movies, music, TV, recreational activities. What should you do when your convictions differ from someone else?

Bonus Question: To what extent are you called to be concerned about what others think? How do you determine whether or not you are being a stumbling block? What can we rightfully call an issue of stumbling? What do you do when different people feel completely differently on an issue and no matter what someone will disagree with your decision?
